FAQ

How will the children learn more about the Romans?

In the carousel of activities the children will have the chance to meet a Roman re-enactment group who explain how their clothes and equipment have been made and allow the children to try some items on. They will also learn about medicines and make up used by the Romans.

What specific links will there be with Minimus?

They will see the Vindolanda tablets in the Romano-British gallery as they answer a quiz about artifacts there.

How will technology feature?

Dr Helen Forte (the illustrator and webmaster) will show the children items from the website. They may try out some of the exercises and new fun activities which are constantly being added.

What will be the costs?

£10 per head for children and extra adults (1 adult per 5 children free), your transport to the museum and pocket money to spend on Minimus Etcera items.
