

Minimus Day at the British Museum

April 26th 2008 – this is the date for your diary.

There will be two separate sessions, morning and afternoon. Each session will have 150 pupil places. The morning is primarily for schools/clubs within reasonable reach of London, the afternoon for those with farther to travel. Please bring enough helpers (free adult places in the ratio 1 to 5) to supervise your group. The day is not suitable for children below Year 4 (aged 8 years upwards).

Participants will enjoy various themed activities, including an opportunity to view the Vindolanda tablets, meet a Roman re-enactment group, and complete a quiz.

There will be a short break in each session for the children to “snack” (Please bring something suitable). There will also be a chance to spend pocket money!

The cost will be £8 (plus your travelling costs).
