

Minimus Day at the British Museum

Saturday June 18th 2016– this is the date for your diary.

There will be two separate sessions, morning and afternoon. The morning session will start at 10am and the afternoon at 2.15pm with registration during the preceding 30 minutes. Each session will have 150 pupil places. The morning is primarily for schools/clubs within reasonable reach of London, the afternoon for those with farther to travel. Please bring enough helpers (free adult places in the ratio 1 to 5) to supervise your group. The day is designed for pupils between years 4 and 8. The programme is not generally suitable for children below Year 4 (aged 8 years upwards). Please contact the organiser if you have younger pupils whom you feel are mature enough to benefit from the activities.

Participants will enjoy various themed activities, including an opportunity to view the Vindolanda tablets, meet a Roman re-enactment group, and complete a quiz.

There will be a short break in each session for the children to “snack” (Please bring something suitable). There will also be a chance to spend pocket money!

The cost will be £10 (plus your travelling costs).
